

## SIMPLE STUDY

### Hebrews 4:16 and Hebrews 10:19:25

At a conference, every attendee was asked to go off alone to read these passages. The following is what I wrote out as I meditated, and I hope it will be of benefit to you.

Hebrews 4:16: Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

How are we to approach the throne? \_\_\_\_\_

This is important because believers in Christ Jesus do have confidence. We are not afraid to approach God. He is our Father and He loves us. And He wants us to come to Him. We abide in Him and He in us

(I John 4:13). At the crucifixion, the temple veil or curtain was torn from top to bottom (Matthew 27:51, Mark 15:38, Luke 23:45). We had no way to get to God until perfect, sinless Jesus died. When He breathed His last breath and the temple veil tore, it symbolized that all who come to God through Jesus would have access always to Him. For now, that access is through prayer to God the Father through Jesus the Son, by the power of the Holy Spirit. We have a trinitarian GOD. One God. Three persons.
