

Matthew 5:8 – Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.

- The Greek word for “**pure**” is katharos.

Usage: clean, pure, unstained, either literally or ceremonially or spiritually; guiltless, innocent, upright.

- The Greek word for “**heart**” is kardeeah.

Usage: lit: the heart; mind, character, inner self, will, intention, center.

In Biblical language the center of the human spirit, from which spring emotions, thoughts, motivations, courage and action — “everything you do flows from it” (**Pr 4:23**).

- The Greek word for “**see**” is horaó: to see, perceive, attend to

Usage: I see, look upon, experience, perceive, discern, beware.
