

# **SIMPLE STUDY - Colossians 2:6-10**

## **Spiritual Fullness in Christ**

<sup>6</sup> So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, <sup>7</sup> rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.

<sup>8</sup> See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces<sup>[a]</sup> of this world rather than on Christ.

<sup>9</sup> For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, <sup>10</sup> and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the head over every power and authority.

## **Ideas for how to read this passage:**

- **Scripture Write it** - For help, type “scripture writing” in my search engine
- **Pray the passage** - Paul is writing to the Colossian church (and to us), encouraging Christians to **continue** in Christ. List the 5 qualities that Paul desires for them and us to grow
  
- **The 5th one is a warning about deception. Write it here:**

- **What verse(s) talk about Christ's deity and power in our lives? Write it~**
  
- **Verse 6 speaks of Christ's authority living in our lives if we know Him. What other verse tells about His authority, and what does it say?**

**Close by repeating the passage. Thank the Lord for every good thing He desires to grow in all His children and praise Him.**

**Find the hymn, "Crown Him with Many Crowns," and sing it to the Lord.**
